

SORBONNE TAX LAW THESIS AWARD 2019

In order to encourage scientific research in Tax Law, the Sorbonne Tax & Public finance Department (Sorbonne Law School - University of Paris 1) organizes a tax thesis award in 2019. The purpose for this award is to annually recognize and promote an outstanding Ph.D. thesis in the domain of **Tax Law**.

The prize-winner will have the possibility to publish his thesis for free in the Public Finance collection of Bruylant. He will be also invited to give a presentation of his research outcome to the Junior Tax Scholars Conference which will be organized by the Sorbonne Tax & Public finance Department in 2019.

The prize is awarded by a jury composed of the Professors and researchers of the Sorbonne Tax & Public finance Department. Theses defended at the University of Paris 1 will be assessed by renowned researchers in Tax Law, non-members of the Sorbonne Tax & Public Finance Department.

Tax thesis award 2019 – conditions for admission

Eligible for application are authors having defended a Ph.D. thesis between January 1, 2018 and December 31, 2018 in France or abroad.

Applicants should send their Ph.D. work in two (2) hard copies or by email in PDF format to the address hereafter. The application should also include:

- The thesis' defense report (or equivalent assessment report by the assessment committee),
- A copy of the candidate's *curriculum vitae*,
- A twenty-five (25) pages summary of the PhD thesis in French or English.

All applications must be sent before **March 31, 2019**.
